	Ray Hartmann brings his 41 years of St. Louis media experience to The Big 550 KTRS from 9pm to Midnight. The well-known and well-connected Hartmann began his career in St. Louis in March of 1977, at the age of 24, he founded Hartmann Publishing and its initial publication, Profile St. Louis. Within months, that paper was dropped and the <i>Riverfront Times</i> was born. Under his ownership, the RFT became one of the ten largest alternative newsweeklies in the nation, and it was twice named Missouri's top news weekly. He sold the paper and bought St. Louis Magazine, where he served as CEO. Ray was showered with local and national honors, and he was also a popular member of the weekly panel on "Donnybrook" on KETC-TV.
